was designed in Switzerland in 19 by both designers Max Miedinger and Eduard Hoffmann. Miedinger was born on December 24, 1926 in Zurich and created his first typeface in 1954.

Hoffmann was born on May 26, 1892 also in Zurich, in 1917 he took a position at Haas Typefoundry where he developed a passion for type. The purpose for Helvetica was to express

**neutrality,  
no impression**

or not have a meaning. The idea was based on type itself shouldn't have a meaning. Helvetica is a sans serif Grotesque typeface because its an oblique style which is common for a Grotesque and the strokes are either vertical or horizontal with tight letter spacing. Helvetica is very similar to Arial which was created in 1982, one key difference would be that Arial uses diagonal strokes as for Helvetica uses vertical or horizontal strokes.

That was willing to sacrifice his life in exchange.

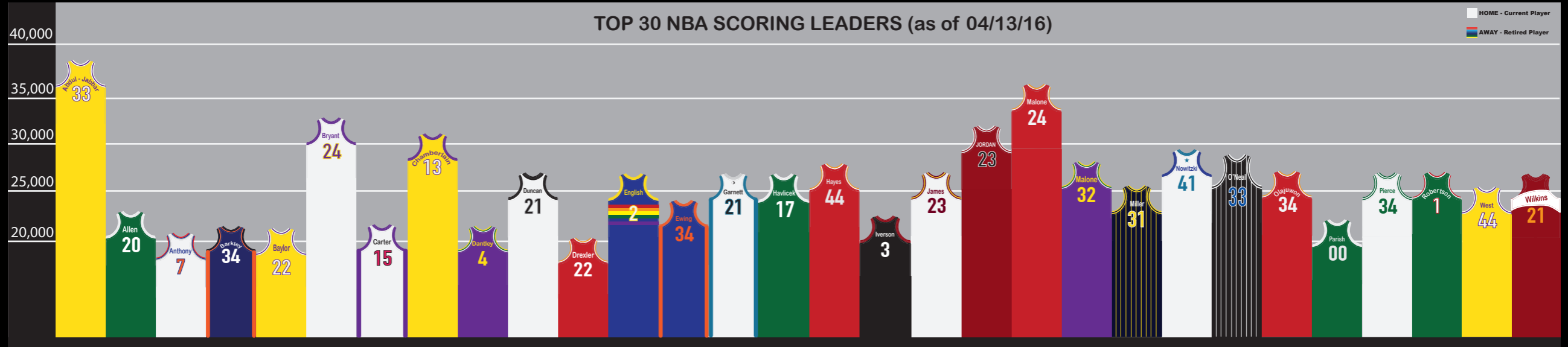
Speaker and leader of many
